- WHAT:** 37th Annual Murray's Mill Harvest Folk Festival:
Celebrating the Heritage and History of the Catawba River Valley
- WHEN:** Saturday, September 25th, 2021, 10:00 am to 5:00 pm
Sunday, September 26th, 2021, 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm
(Dates and times are subject to Covid mandates.)
- WHERE:** Murray's Mill Historic District, 1489 Murray's Mill Road, Catawba, N.C. 28609
- SPACE:** Displays are to be set up in 10' x 10' space provided.
Electricity needs should be identified below, but are not assured.
- EQUIPMENT:** Bring your own, including table, chairs, and an appropriate cover in case of rain &/or sun.
- REGISTRATION FEE:** Registration is \$125 and includes both days.
- REGULATIONS:** 1) Set-up will be Saturday from 7 to 9:00 am & vehicles must be removed to parking lot by 9:30 am.
You are welcome to set up on Friday.
2) Parking: after you have unloaded your vehicle, please move it to all day parking nearby.
3) Someone must be present at your booth at all times.
4) Each booth must be free of litter. Trash containers will be provided.
5) HACC can assume NO responsibility for loss/damage of your work.
6) You are encouraged to demonstrate your craft and provide a visually appealing exhibit.
7) Check in upon arrival to site @ open shelter @ top of hill in front of John Murray House.
8) Vendor canopies should be free of tent ropes/cords that obstruct walking traffic at tent.
9) Vendor is responsible for all-appropriate county & state permits and rules.
10) Please provide non-returnable photo of craft with application, if new vendor to site.
11) Booth space is limited and HACC reserves the right not to honor a request for a booth.
12) Craft vendors are not allowed to sell drinks of any kind at their booth.
13) Items must be family-friendly. No nudity, profanity, or politics.
13) Please return application by September 1st, 2021.
